A man committed to the Caledon community was recently honoured by Caledon council with the Senior of the Year Award.

The award went to David Armstrong.

Each year the Ontario government designates June as Seniors' Month to celebrate the countless experiences and contributions of seniors. The Senior of the Year Award was established in 1994 to give each municipality in Ontario the opportunity to honour one outstanding local senior annually.

Recipients are usually

individuals, who after 65 years of age, have enriched the social, cultural or civic life of the community, without thought of personal or financial gain.

Mayor Marolyn Morrison said Armstrong's volunteer accomplishments are tremendous and the list lengthy.
