Mayor Morrison starts her re-election campaign

After filing her papers to officially start her re-election campaign, Caledon Mayor Marolyn Morrison says her style of open and active communication that became the theme for Town staff and her council, will be the same style she uses to connect with citizens during the days leading to the November municipal elections.

"We have opened our doors and turned on the creativity at the Town of Caledon in the last three years and the results have been improved service, more collaboration,

improved staff morale and a great deal more access for citizens and clients overall," Morrison said. "I started this term as mayor by setting some lofty commitments about changes that needed to be made and relationships with our business community that needed to

be forged. I am proud to say that we have gelled together as an organization and as a community and the result is that Caledon is thriving."

At the top of Morrison's list of commitments achieved is responsible fiscal planning.

"I am so very proud to be

able to say that the Town of Caledon will be debt-free in 2006," she said. "We needed to create a strong plan and have the discipline to stick to it, and we have done just that. The result is that by the end of this year, not one tax dollar raised for programs will need to be directed toward servicing debt. This places Caledon in a very rare group of highly successful communities. It is exciting to look toward our future from this achievement.

"Building trust and confidence in government means setting the bar for services very high and winning all of the many 'moments of truth' through great service. I committed at the start to establishing benchmarks for the services offered by the Town and to report regularly on these, and I am proud to say that our Town of Caledon Progress Report is a great demonstration of our transparency and accountability."

Several internal changes to Town operations committed to by Morrison and successfully completed include the new position of environmental progress officer, streamlining of the building permit process and the creation of an economic development and communications department.
