Riders from Canada and the U.S. will be at the fair showcasing their stunt and trick abilities as they fly through the air. On the main stage before and after the freestyle show will be a performance by a new local band named Subject to Change.

The aroma of sausages and pancakes should draw crowds to the fairgrounds Sunday morning for the pancake breakfast starting at 8 a.m. The Community Church Service will begin at 10 a.m. on the main stage. Your church envelope will be your admission to the fair.

The goat show will be starting at 11 a.m. in the arena and at the fairgrounds will be a display of active and restored tractors and implements. Registration will begin at 9 a.m. to have your tractor judged and there will be a parade of the tractors at 2:30 p.m. The baby show is back again this year with an exciting "carrot top" class. Be sure to be at the main stage at 2 p.m. to see all the beautiful babies.

Entertainment throughout the afternoon will be Miss Jenni and Company, magician Ben Burland and the Pet Show (main stage 1 p.m.). The always entertaining cow milking competition is back again this year. Come out to see three teams battle it out to win the title

of Cow Milking Competition winner 2006. You won't want to miss this.

At 4 p.m. the President's Building closes its doors

and on the main stage there will be a trophy presentation for winners of the weekend.

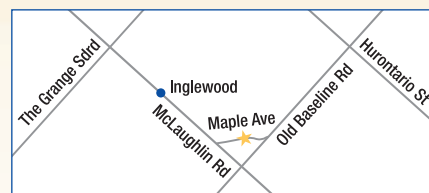
