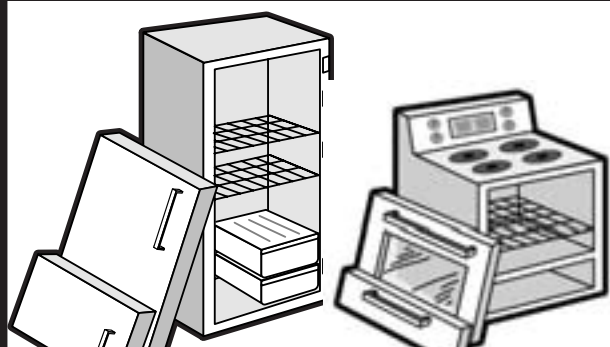

For safety reasons, remove the door and put it beside the appliance.

Got appliances you need to get rid of? Give us a call. We can pick them up from your curb.

Items accepted for curbside pick up include:

- refrigerators
- washers and dryers
- stoves
- furnaces
- freezers
- dishwashers
- air conditioners
- pool heaters
- heat pumps/exchangers
- fireplaces
- metal bath tubs
- metal shower enclosures
- dehumidifiers
- empty hot water tanks
- large home safes
- empty oil heating tanks (cut in half)

There is a \$15 collection fee for the first item and \$10 for each additional item collected the same day.

Note: Residents can drop off any of the listed appliances and large metal fixtures at a Region of Peel Community Recycling Centre free of charge.

THIS FALL, DON'T FORGET TO PLACE YOUR HOLIDAY LEFTOVERS IN YOUR ORGANICS CART

Organics Cart

Your organics cart takes yard waste, vegetables, pumpkins including pumpkin seeds, pies and all other organic materials.

Pumpkins

Break your pumpkin into small pieces and remove as much of the candle wax out of the pumpkin as possible.

Other Materials

Other materials such as grass and leaves should be layered with food waste and placed directly into the organics cart.

Branches should be bundled, tied securely and placed beside your cart. Excess leaves and grass should be placed in open, rigid containers, bushel baskets or paper yard waste bags and placed beside your cart.

Do not use plastic bags.
