"We are using this grant to educate our coaches and purchase equipment that will ensure not only more competitive swimmers but also promote a healthy lifestyle for our children," said head coach Brian Kelly.

The Dorado Stars Swim Club's mission statement is to provide appropriate competitive opportunities in the pursuit of excellence in swimming, in an environment dedicated to the promotion of sportsmanship, friendship, self esteem, and the achievement of personal goals. The swim club is a not-for-profit organization since 1979 that is proud to call Caledon home.
