## Car hit mailboxes, left the scene

Caledon OPP officers responded to 28 property damage and two personal injury collisions during the week ending Jan. 22. Sadly, there was one fatality.

### Traffic

Caledon OPP and OPP Technical Collision Investigators are continuing their investigation of a collision involving a car and a truck on Airport Road near Patterson Sideroad that occurred Jan. 18, at approximately 10:35 a.m. Tragically, the driver of the car did not survive from the injuries he sustained as a result of the collision. The deceased has been identified as 49-year-old Fiore Isabella of Mississauga. The driver of the truck, 56-year-old Dave Woodford of Orangeville was not injured in the collision.

### High Miler

Wednesday, Jan. 3, at approximately 6:25 p.m., a Caledon OPP officer observed a motor vehicle traveling at an extreme high rate of speed southbound on Kennedy Road near Beechgrove Sideroad in Caledon.
