

An evening of stewardship for landowners on the Moraine

Landowners in Caledon, King and surrounding areas are invited to an evening of short presentations and information on stewardship at an upcoming open house organized by the Caring for the Moraine Project, western headwaters area.

The event takes place on Thursday, Feb. 22, at the

Schomberg Arena Hall, 251 Western Ave., Schomberg, west off Main St., just south of Hwy 9.

Highlights of the evening include local Oak Ridges Moraine landowners who will offer insight into their experiences on practicing stewardship on their properties.

The meeting will also provide landowners with an opportunity to learn more about the various stewardship programs and services offered by the many organizations participating in the Caring for the Moraine Project. Technical advice will be available on subjects such as wetlands, forestry, streams, and legal options to protect the natural features of your property.
