

# Peel Region adjusts hours for Family Day this Monday

Peel Region offices and non-emergency services will be closed this Monday (Feb. 16) for the Family Day holiday.

The Regional headquarters and most offices will re-open for regular business Tuesday.

## Gay-Straight Alliance youth conference coming this month

The past year has seen positive movement in support for LGBTQ (lesbian, gay, bisexual, transgendered and queer) youth in Peel, with students becoming involved in GSAs (Gay-Straight Alliances), supporting anti-homophobia and transphobia work, as well as further development of the first LGBTQ youth program, launched at Associated Youth Services of Peel (AYSP) in November 2007.

AYSP, the Peel District School Board and the Positive Space Coalition of Peel have partnered to organize the first student led GSA conference for the Region of Peel. This first conference for LGBTQ students and their allies is to be held at the Peel District School Board Feb. 25.

The objectives in planning this conference are to provide opportunities for students to participate in workshops focussed on

LGBTQ issues and to gain knowledge about resources available to them, and for them to be able to make connections with other LGBTQ students in an environment where they feel supported.

The conference is intended for Peel board students only this year, although the planning committee hopes to expand things in future years to include other school boards and more community

partners.

Social service agencies are invited to set up community booths free of charge.
