For the past six years, this small group of women has donated the proceeds from this

annual event to Canadian Aid for Chernobyl. This year, they decided to make their focus Women helping Women, and direct some of the funds to assist closer to home. They decided to support Caledon Community Services (CCS), so the proceeds of their dance

will be split between the two charities.

CCS propose using their new found support from this dance to fund additional personnel to closely assist women in the Caledon area with mentoring, counselling, job searches and child care to

facilitate them in their efforts to gain confidence and independence. Their hope is to be able to multiply the donation through matching funds from government agencies.

Canadian aid for Chernobyl has used the funds donated in past years in a vari-

ety of ways, including the purchase of a mini-bus for school activities, new bathrooms and beds for the orphans. This year, the goal is to direct the funds toward assisting in the purchase of a mini-bus to provide many invalid children living in rural areas of Belarus

the opportunity to attend the daycare/learning facility in Chausy at one of the orphanages long supported by the group. Here they will be able to socialize and do crafts while providing their parents with the time to search for urgently needed employment.

The long term effect of radiation is still huge. One of the sorority members visits Belarus annually to deliver the aid purchased here in Canada and she has annually brought orphans to Caledon in the summer for respite they greatly benefit from.

## Household Hazardous Waste Disposal

Unused or expired medication from doctors or veterinarians should never be flushed down a toilet, poured down a drain or placed in garbage or recycling containers. If not properly disposed of, chemical components of medication may contaminate soil and water.



Return all unused or expired medication to any of Peel's Community Recycling Centres (CRCs) for proper disposal, free of charge.

Caustic chemicals – such as rust remover, all purpose household cleaners, mercury from old thermostats/thermometers, powdered cement or floor/tile grout – are made up of corrosive acids and bases that can burn or irritate exposed skin and harm the environment if flushed down a toilet, poured down a drain or placed in garbage or recycling containers.



Return all acids and bases to any of Peel's Community Recycling Centres (CRCs) for proper disposal, free of charge.

Peel's CRCs are for use by Peel residents only. No institutional, commercial or industrial hazardous waste is accepted as HHW.
